He understood that Varijatsy was in danger.

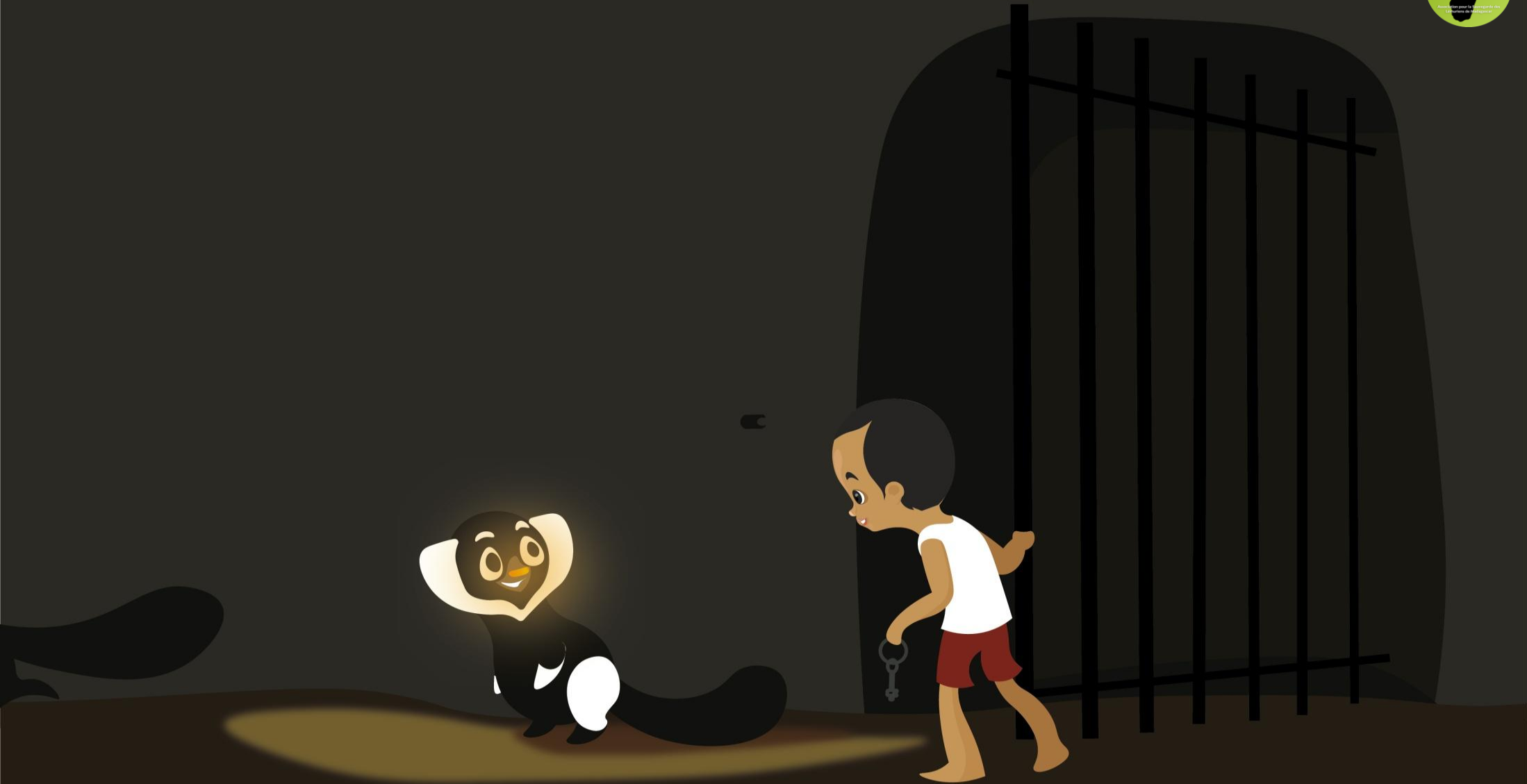
Guided by the light,

of the cave.



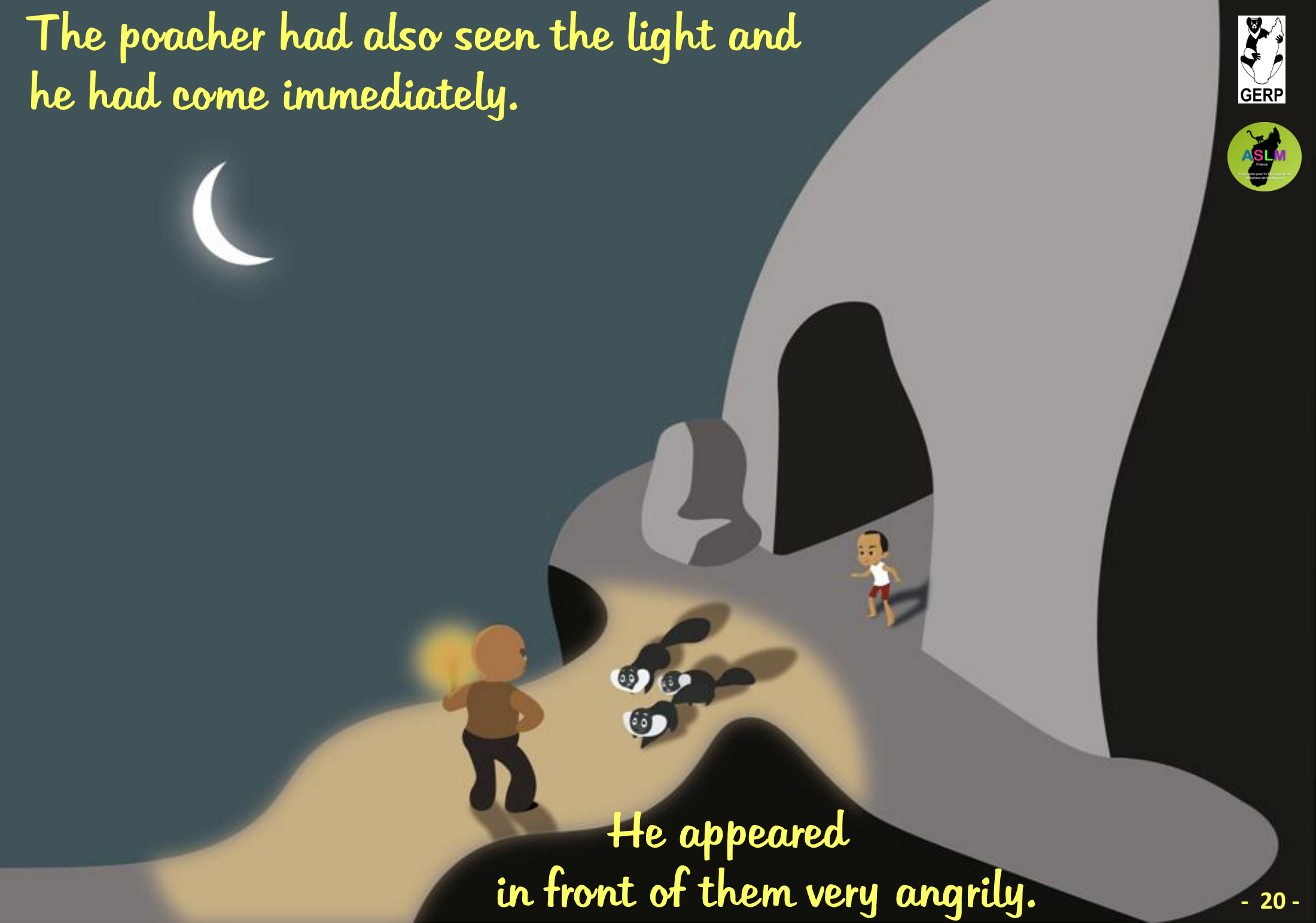
He entered and found his friend surrounded by his family.



He delivered them and they hurried out of the cave.



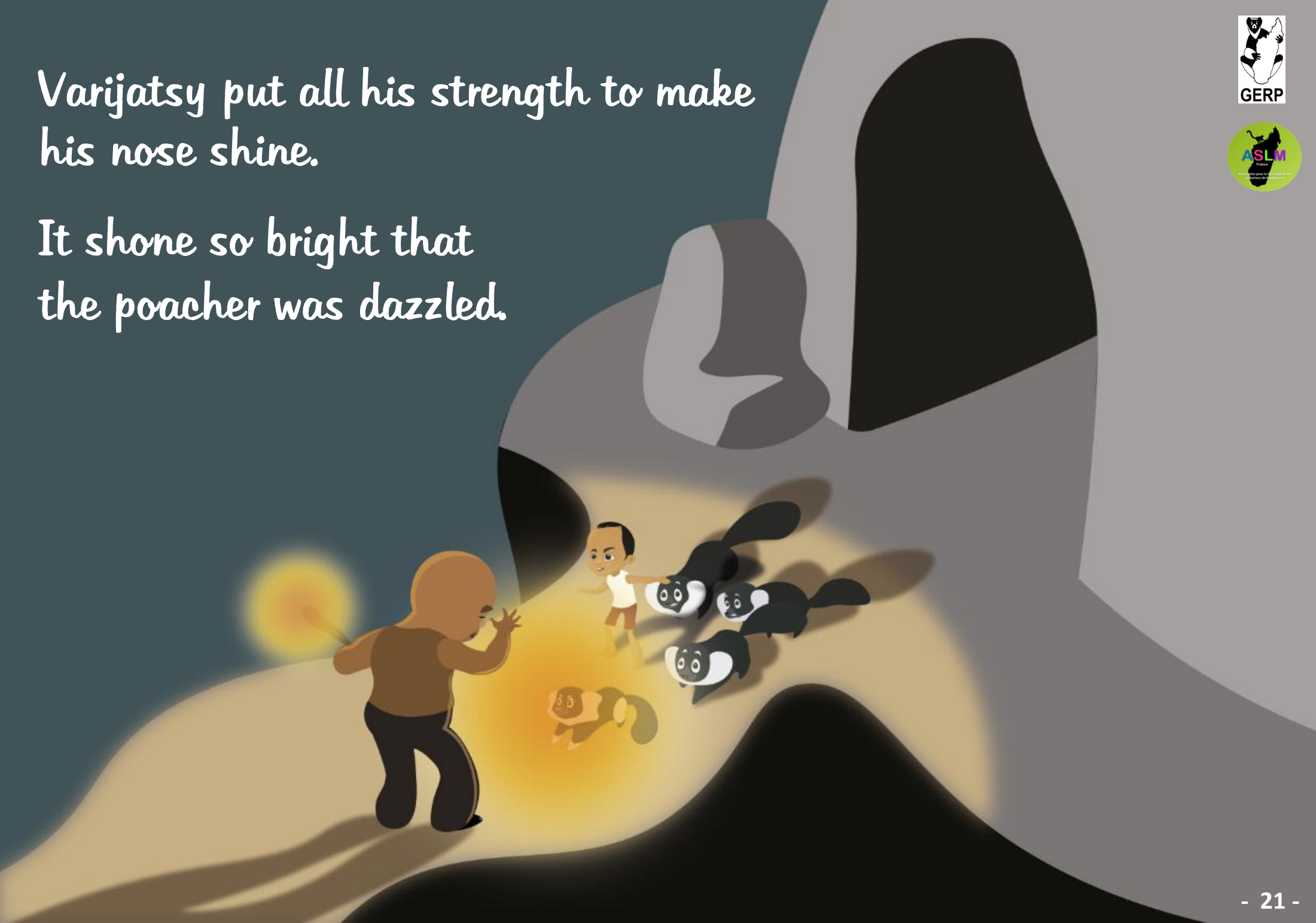
The poacher had also seen the light and he had come immediately.
